

Local Stakeholder Manager at Ørsted Taiwan

You will be based in Changhua, Taiwan.

This role is responsible for managing Ørsted's internal and external stakeholder relations in Central Taiwan. Work with relevant internal and external stakeholders in support of Ørsted's wind projects with a focus on Taiwan. To raise the profile of Ørsted's investment in Taiwan and the broader benefits it is delivering on a regional and national level. To help deliver education and training activities in Taiwan to stimulate talent pipeline for Ørsted's future recruitment needs and for outreach around STEM based careers.

Your key tasks will be to

- Develop and manage a strong understanding of the wider Taiwan context (i.e. Changhua county and central Taiwan) and how such initiatives relate to Ørsted activities
- Attend and organise local, regional, and international events in Taiwan as a Ørsted representative / ambassador, including for skills initiatives
- Dialogue with local and regional politicians, NGOs, as and when required.
- Be actively involved in local communities and be aware of local issues (present and anticipated) that could impact Ørsted business and report back to senior management and internals' stakeholders as appropriate
- Coordinate closely with Communications, Project, Communications and Market Development teams to ensure the timely delivery of Ørsted's media plans to fit with internal and external events and milestones and consistency of approach
- Ensure compliance with Ørsted's policies for external engagement including sponsorships, community benefits and contributions and broader strategy
- Closely align with Ørsted O&M and construction teams in the area to ensure clear and consistent message is delivered to stakeholders in Taiwan
- Establish and maintain stakeholder map to identify key stakeholders, to develop and maintain relationships
- Provide regular briefings and reports on background and assumptions to external policy view of the energy market to ensure internal stakeholders are kept up to date with relevant external developments
- Identify and support key relationships within the business to ensure consistency of approach at external meetings
- Host Ørsted delegations at local and regional sites when needed, and act as gatekeeper for Ørsted in Central Taiwan, and accompany Ørsted employees to relevant relationship.
- As this role is a first for Ørsted in Taiwan, there are likely to be parts of the role which will need to be undertaken on an ad-hoc basis and will develop over time. Subsequently, someone who enjoys flexibility in their role and is a self-starter is essential
- Reporting into the Head of governmental and regulatory affairs and working with the broader Stakeholder and Regulatory and Communications teams to understand key objectives for engagement and delivery in Taiwan where necessary

- Taiwanese and Mandarin native speaker
